MEN'S CHAMPIONSHIP PLAYOFF RULES 2018

GENERAL RULES

- All Canadian Curling Assoc. rules apply (see posted CCA rules or CurlBC Yearbook)
- Games are 8 Ends
- In the event of a tie, extra ends will be played to determine the winner
- Coin flip will give team a choice of hammer or rock colour
- Draws to the button will break three way ties (see draw sheet)
- All brush heads are permitted, but the winner will be required to play with competition approved brush heads for the [Mainland Club Championships](#)

SPARES

- All teams must have at least 3 regular team members, or the game will be defaulted.
 - If one spare is required, the spare must play lead.
- Only members and current curlers of the RCC may spare in the club's playoffs and they must be registered in one of the leagues. EG: Club League, Commercial League, Day Ladies, Senior Men's will be eligible.
 - Note: No one from outside the club may spare in the playoffs.
- [Travellers Curling Club Championship Eligibility Rules](#) also apply to spares
 - Only one player may have played in a junior's, men's, or senior's provincial competition for the previous four curling seasons. THIS INCLUDES SPARES.

The Club's "Draws & Rules Committee" is responsible for all the draws, rules & decisions.
